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Taxation and Revenue Offers Services This Weekend

The New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department will be well represented at Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham's [Cabinet in Your Community](#) event this Saturday, August 10, in Albuquerque.

The event offers a chance for constituents to get help with questions, government programs and services. It will take place from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Carpenters Local 1319 Union Hall, 3900 Pan American Frwy NE.

Taxation and Revenue Secretary Stephanie Schardin Clarke will be on hand along with the department's Taxpayer Advocate, a constituent services representative, the Motor Vehicle Division's Mobile Unit and representatives prepared to assist with questions related to tax payments, tax audits and claiming unclaimed property.

The following services will be available on Saturday:

- The MVD Mobile Unit. Staff will process typical transactions such as renewing driver's licenses and vehicle registrations. Residents should come prepared with all necessary documentation they'll need for their transaction. (See links below)
- Representatives from TRD's Unclaimed Property Unit will be on hand to help people search for money or assets that may be owed to them and explain the process for filing a claim. Banks, insurance companies, investment companies and many other businesses are required by law to surrender inactive accounts to the state. The Unclaimed Property Unit serves as the custodian of this money until it is claimed by rightful owners.
- Taxation and Revenue's Taxpayer Advocate will be available to answer questions. The Taxpayer Advocate can help resolve state tax issues when the normal process has broken down and ensures that rights afforded under the state's Taxpayer Bill of Rights are protected.

- The Audit and Compliance Division Call Center, 866-285-2996, will be accepting calls from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
