Albuquerque Man Indicted on Tax Evasion Charges

SANTA FE – An Albuquerque man has been indicted on tax evasion charges for failing to pay his personal income taxes for four years.

A grand jury for the Second Judicial District in Albuquerque on Thursday returned an indictment against Robert Giles on four counts of tax evasion charges for failing to pay his personal incomes taxes from 2008 through 2011.

Giles, 62, owes in excess of \$4,500 in back taxes, interest and penalties. He has not been arrested, but a criminal summons will be issued ordering his appearance before a district court judge in Albuquerque. An arraignment date has not been set.

This case was investigated by the Tax Fraud Investigation Division of the State Taxation and Revenue Department and is being prosecuted by the Second Judicial District Attorney's Office.
