TRD SECRETARY UNVEILS NEW WEB PROGRAM TO ASSIST TAXPAYERS(TAP)

SANTA FE – TRD Secretary Jan Goodwin unveiled a new web-based program today (TAP) that will give taxpayers new options to check the status of their tax refunds as well as check on all tax filings. "We want New Mexicans to be able to access their tax information securely and easily," stated Secretary Goodwin.

- This service is now available for all taxpayers, individuals and businesses. It will significantly reduce the time for taxpayers to get answers to their questions.
Taxpayers can check the status of their tax refunds 24/7. This will dramatically reduce taxpayer time associated with telephone calls, visits to TRD field offices or mail correspondence.
Individuals and businesses can access the status of all tax filings, payments and accounts.
Taxpayers can make online payments for personal income, corporate and gross receipts tax programs at any time.
The service provides access to information for 13 tax programs including Personal Income, Corporate Income, Gross Receipts, Combined Fuel, Cigarette, Fiduciary Income, Water Conservation, Liquor Excise, Tobacco Products, Telecom Relay, Weight Distance, E-911 and Workers Compensation.
