E-FILING BEGINS 19th YEAR FOR PERSONAL INCOME TAX RETURNS

SANTA FE – E-Filing for Personal Income Tax Returns was launched for the tax year 2006, on January 16, 2007. This is the nineteenth year some form of e-filing has been available to New Mexico Taxpayers. As of this week, 39,726 returns have been filed for Personal Income Tax. Of that 33,001 filed using federal/state electronic filing and 3,700 filed using PIT-NET, for a total of 36,701 returns filed electronically of the 39,726 returns. That is a percentage of 92% in the system that is electronically filed.

"I want to encourage all New Mexicans to file their tax returns online-not only will you receive your refund check within 7 days-we can also deposit your refund check directly into your personal checking or savings account," stated Jan Goodwin, Secretary of Taxation and Revenue. E-filing is **fast, free and secure**- at the end of calendar year 2005, 447,776 taxpayers out of 933,205 filed electronically-48%. By mid December, 2006, 507,286 taxpayers have filed electronically out of 987,975 total returns-51%. E-Filing allows you until April 30, 2007 to file your tax return.
