Albuquerque woman faces embezzlement, tax evasion charges

A 57-year-old Albuquerque woman has been indicted on embezzlement and tax evasion charges.

Hyuna King was indicted January 29, 2020 on two counts of embezzlement over \$20,000, three counts of embezzlement over \$2,500, one count of embezzlement over \$500, and two counts of attempting to evade or defeat tax, all felonies. King faces as much as 30 years in prison and fines of up to \$50,000 if convicted on all counts.

The indictment alleges that between 2015 and 2017, King converted to her own use business checks from her employer, Wolf & Fox P.C., and attempted to evade taxes in 2015 and 2016.

The case was investigated by the Albuquerque Police Department and the Tax Fraud Investigations Division of the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department. It is being prosecuted by the 2nd Judicial District Attorney's Office in Albuquerque.
