Delinquent property tax auction scheduled in Curry County

SANTA FE—The Taxation and Revenue Department has scheduled a delinquent property tax auction for Curry County on August 30, 2022.

The state attempts to collect delinquent property taxes when counties are unable to do so. If the state is unable to collect the delinquent taxes, the subject properties are auctioned for sale.

The auction will take place at 417 Gidding Street, Suite 150, Clovis NM 88101 beginning at 10 a.m.

Registration begins in person one hour before the auction starts and ends promptly at auction time. Bidders must be registered to participate.
