New paper Gross Receipts Tax Filer's Kits available on request Packets will no longer be mailed automatically

SANTA FE—The paper Gross Receipts Tax Filer's Kits for the January-June 2023 period are available and can be ordered by phone, picked up at district field offices or downloaded from tax.newmexico.gov.

Filer's kits are no longer being mailed automatically to taxpayers who have received them in the past.

Taxpayers are urged to use the Taxpayer Access Point online portal at <u>tap.state.nm.us</u> for filing GRT returns. Filing online is convenient, fast and secure.

Taxpayers who do not have computer access can pick up paper kits at any Taxation and Revenue district field office or order one by calling 505-827-6851. The kits also are available in the Business Taxes folder on the Forms & Publications page at tax.newmexico.gov.

Gross Receipts Tax rates can change twice a year, in January and July. The January to June 2023 <u>rate tables</u> are available on the Gross Receipts Location Code and Tax Rate Map page at tax.newmexico.gov.
