

You are receiving this message because your Taxpayer Access Point (TAP) Logon has recently bulk filed XML returns with the New Mexico Taxation & Revenue Department.

The Department is redesigning its Combined Reporting System (CRS) to create separate tax returns for specific business tax programs. Bulk filing will be available for wage withholding, gross receipts, compensating, and interstate telecommunications taxes. If you wish to continue to file bulk returns for these programs after June 30, 2021, you will be required to move to new XML schemas. The format of CRS XML file you submit today will no longer work.

Additionally, the Department will be updating its TAP e-filing portal for a more intuitive, user-friendly interface. TAP, including bulk filing, is expected to be unavailable from the close of business June 30th until the morning of July 6th as we make the transition.
