2021 Personal and Corporate Income Tax forms now available

Personal Income Tax and Corporate Income Tax forms for the 2021 tax year are now available online.

Taxpayers, tax professionals and others can access the new forms and instructions at tax.newmexico.gov by opening the <u>Forms & Publications</u> page and then the Income Taxes folder.

Paper forms and instructions are not yet available.

New Mexico Taxation and Revenue is awaiting word from the IRS on when it will begin accepting returns. Tax returns for the 2021 tax year are due on April 18 this year, as opposed to the usual April 15 deadline because of the Emancipation Day holiday in Washington D.C.

Taxpayers are encouraged to file electronically, either through a commercial service or directly on the Department's website through the Taxpayer Access Point (TAP). Filing electronically minimizes delays in processing and results in faster refunds.

The Taxation and Revenue Department serves the State of New Mexico by providing fair and efficient tax and motor vehicle services. It administers more than 35 tax programs and distributes revenue to the State and to local and tribal governments throughout New Mexico.
