Delinquent property tax auctions scheduled

SANTA FE—The Taxation and Revenue Department has scheduled delinquent property tax auctions in Grant and San Miguel counties this month.

The state attempts to collect delinquent property taxes when counties are unable to do so. If the state is unable to collect the delinquent taxes, the subject properties are auctioned for sale.

Auctions have been scheduled in the following counties.

Grant County. When: 10 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 16, 2022. Where: 1400 Highway 180 East, Silver City.

San Miguel County. When: 10 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 30, 2022. Where: 500 West National Ave., Las Vegas.

More information, including terms of the auction sales, is available on the <u>tax.newmexico.gov</u>. Announcements of future auctions also will be available there.

Registration begins in person one hour before the auction starts and ends promptly at auction time. Bidders must be registered to participate.
