Delinquent property tax auction scheduled

SANTA FE—The Taxation and Revenue Department has scheduled a delinquent property tax auction next week Valencia County.

The state attempts to collect delinquent property taxes when counties are unable to do so. If the state is unable to collect the delinquent taxes, the subject properties are auctioned for sale.

The Valencia County auction will take place at 10 a.m., Thursday, April 20, 2023 in the Daniel Fernandez Gymnasium, 1103 NM 314, Los Lunas. Registration opens at 8 a.m. and closes when the auction begins at 10 a.m.

Bidders must be registered to participate.

The auction will be of multiple properties in southern Valencia County, and many of the parcels are adjoining.
