Delinquent property tax auctions scheduled

SANTA FE—The Taxation and Revenue Department has scheduled delinquent property tax auctions in McKinley, Torrance and Mora Counties.

The state attempts to collect delinquent property taxes when counties are unable to do so. If the state is unable to collect the delinquent taxes, the subject properties are auctioned for sale.

Auctions have been scheduled in the following counties.

McKinley County. When: 10 a.m., Wednesday, May 24, 2023. Where: McKinley County Courthouse, 207 West Hill Ave, Gallup.

Torrance County. When: 10 a.m., Thursday, May 25, 2023. Where: Torrance County Administration Building, 205 S. 9th Street, Estancia.

Mora County. When: 10 a.m., Wednesday, May 31, 2023. Where: 1 Courthouse Drive, Mora.

More information, including terms of the auction sales, is available on the Delinquent Property Tax Auctions page at <u>tax.newmexico.gov</u>. Announcements of future auctions also will be available there.

Registration begins in person one hour before the auction starts and ends promptly at auction time. Bidders must be registered to participate.
