MVD expands self-service kiosk program Instant registration renewal now available at 5 locations in Albuquerque

SANTA FE –Self-service kiosks for New Mexico motor vehicle transactions are now available at five locations in the Albuquerque area.

The Motor Vehicle Division first launched the kiosk program in partnership with Intellectual Technology Inc. in 2021 as a way to expand customer service choices. The kiosks have an easyto-use touch screen that allows customers to instantly renew and print their vehicle registrations and stickers. Customers also can pay traffic citations that are payable to MVD and purchase their driver history record.

"We're always excited when we can expand options for customers and make doing business with us as easy as possible," said Taxation and Revenue Secretary Stephanie Schardin Clarke.

The kiosks previously were available at three locations in Albuquerque. With this new expansion, they are now available in five Albuquerque Smith's and Albertsons Market locations:



Albertsons Market at 11825 Lomas Blvd. NE, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Albertsons Market at 4950 Montgomery Blvd. NE, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Smith's at 8100 Wyoming Blvd. NE, 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. Smith's at 111 Coors Blvd. NW, 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. Smith's at 4800 McMahon Blvd. NW, 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

The kiosks are part of a strategy to offer customers a variety of ways to conduct business with MVD that are most convenient to them. Other customer options include visiting inperson at state-run field offices and offices run by private or municipal partners, conducting business online at mvdonline.com and for some transactions by phone at 888-683-4636.
