Delinquent property tax auctions scheduled in August

SANTA FE – The Taxation and Revenue Department will hold delinquent property tax auctions in Guadalupe, San Juan, Rio Arriba, Mora, Valencia, and Sandoval counties in August, open to individuals in attendance to bid on.

The state attempts to collect delinquent property taxes when counties are unable to collect for themselves. The state notifies delinquent taxpayers about the taxes due and planned sales of delinquent property. If the state is unable to collect the delinquent taxes, the subject properties are auctioned for sale.

- **Mora**, 10 a.m., August 19, at 1 Courthouse Dr., Mora, New Mexico 87732
- **Valencia**, 10 a.m., August 21, at Commissioner's Chambers, 444 Luna Ave., Los Lunas, New Mexico 87031
- **Sandoval**, 10 a.m., August 27, at Bernalillo Recreation Center, 370 Rotary Park Rd., Bernalillo, New Mexico 87004
- **Sandoval**, 10 a.m., August 28, at Bernalillo Recreation Center, 370 Rotary Park Rd., Bernalillo, New Mexico 87004
