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Reminder: Taxation and Revenue Offers Services This Weekend

Representatives from the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department will be available tomorrow, August 10, to help constituents at Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham's first [Cabinet in Your Community](#) event.

Constituents will be able to get help with questions, government programs and services. The event will be from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Carpenters Local 1319 Union Hall, 3900 Pan American Frwy NE.

The following services will be available from the Department on Saturday:

- The MVD Mobile Unit. Staff will process typical transactions such as renewing driver's licenses and vehicle registrations. Residents should come prepared with all necessary documentation they'll need for their transaction. (See links below)
- Representatives from TRD's Unclaimed Property Unit will be on hand to help people search for money or assets that may be owed to them and explain the process for filing a claim. Banks, insurance companies, investment companies and many other businesses are required by law to surrender inactive accounts to the state. The Unclaimed Property Unit serves as the custodian of this money until it is claimed by rightful owners.
- Taxation and Revenue's Taxpayer Advocate will be available to answer questions. The Taxpayer Advocate can help resolve state tax issues when the normal process has broken down and ensures that rights afforded under the state's Taxpayer Bill of Rights are protected.
- The MVD Call Center will be answering calls at 888-683-4636 (888-MVD-INFO) from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- The Audit and Compliance Division Call Center, 866-285-2996, will be accepting calls from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
