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New services available on MVD kiosks

New Mexico motorists can now pay for traffic citations at the Motor Vehicle Division's two automated kiosks in Albuquerque.

The Division's kiosks are located in the Albertson's stores at Montgomery and San Mateo and at Juan Tabo and Candelaria.

The recently added capability allows drivers to pay citations that are payable to the Motor Vehicle Division. The kiosks cannot accept citations payable to courts.

To pay a citation, customers simply enter their citation number and choose the payment method. All major credit cards are accepted, and the transaction will incur a \$3.95 charge from the kiosk vendor as well as a 2.3% transaction credit card transaction fee.

Transactions can be completed in either English or Spanish and are ADA compliant.

Citation payments made at the kiosks will update the record in real time.

The kiosks already had been available for customers to renew their vehicle registrations. With that service, customers receive both their updated registration and their license plate sticker from the kiosk.
