Hearing scheduled on new rules for New Mexico driver's licenses

The Taxation and Revenue Department has scheduled a hearing for July 23 on new rules for obtaining a New Mexico driver's license under the 2019 law that, among other changes, created the New Mexico Standard License.

The Motor Vehicle Division began issuing Standard Driver's Licenses in October 2019. The Taxation and Revenue Department will accept comments on the proposed rules for obtaining those licenses as well as some proposed changes to the rules for obtaining a Real ID-compliant driver's license.

The proposed rules would establish identification, residency and other documentation requirements for obtaining Real ID Licenses and Standard Licenses in accordance with the 2019 law. Among other changes, fingerprints will no longer be required for any New Mexico driver's license.
